We have been blessed with a wonderful summer! The temps have been pleasant, the sun abundant, and the rains not overbearing. I hope that we continue to experience such welcomed weather as we end our summer season and begin another Fall and school season.

For much of the summer I took a break from writing a weekly bulletin article posting instead various reflections from some of my favorite biblical commentators. Now I'm back at my computer and would like to share with you some important parish information and updates.

**Summer Mission Appeal** The annual Summer Mission Appeal of the Archdiocese of Chicago will take place at our parish on the weekend of August 25<sup>th</sup> and 26<sup>th</sup>. Fr. Daniel, a Claretian Missionary will celebrate all of our masses and share with us details of his missionary work and ministry. Let us give Fr. Daniel a warm welcome and show him our generous support.

Because of Fr. Daniel's willingness to celebrate all our masses that weekend I am going to take a few days of vacation. I will be in Charlotte, North Carolina from August 23<sup>rd</sup>-28<sup>th</sup>. There will be no daily mass on Monday August 27<sup>th</sup>.

**CADC Certification** At the beginning of this current calendar year I was asked by the Archdiocese to serve as the Priest liaison for the Mental Health and Addictions Committee of the Archdiocese. To serve in that capacity I needed to attain the CADC Certification and have been attending classes every Tuesday, Wednesday, and Thursday evening since March. My last class is September 20<sup>th</sup> and I will take the test administered through the State of Illinois on Saturday October 20<sup>th</sup>. I hope to be back into a regular parish schedule once classes end.

### **Religious Education and Catholic Faith Formation for Adults**

- Registration for new students in our Religious Education Program (CCD) will take place on the weekend of September 8<sup>th</sup>-9<sup>th</sup> in the church after all the masses. Children and families who attended last year's program have been notified via the mail and do not need to reregister on this weekend. Please consult our bulletin and parish website for more information or speak with Lisa Ortiz if you have any questions.
- Any adult or teen over the age of 16 who has yet to receive their sacraments of initiation (Baptism, Eucharist, Confirmation) or who want to become Catholic are most welcome to join our parish's RCIA program. Classes will begin towards the end of September. RCIA for adults meet on Sunday Mornings and RCIA for Teens meet on Friday Evenings. Please see me or call the parish office for more information.
- The Neocatechumenal Way is offering a Fall Catechesis for all parishioners beginning Tuesday September 11<sup>th</sup>.

**Certificación de CADC** Al comienzo de este año calendario actual, la Arquidiócesis me pidió que me desempeñara como enlace de Sacerdotes para el Comité de Salud Mental y Adicciones de la Arquidiócesis. Para servir en esa capacidad, necesitaba obtener la Certificación CADC y asistí a clases todos los martes, miércoles y jueves por la tarde desde marzo. Mi última clase es el 20 de septiembre y tomaré la prueba administrada a través del estado de Illinois el sábado 20 de octubre. Espero volver a un horario regular de parroquia una vez que terminen las clases.

### **Educación Religiosa y Formación de Fe Católica para adultos**

RELIGIOUS EDUCATION  
2018-2019 School Year**

Registration for our Religious Education Program will be under way soon!

Do you know someone who needs to make a sacrament and is in grammar school? Is your child a little behind on sacraments? Was your child enrolled last year? Did you know that religious education should be attended every year that your child is in grammar school? If you need registration papers, please call the rectory and ask for Lisa Ortiz and/or leave your name and address and we will get the packet mailed out to you.

For last years students, packets will automatically be mailed to you. You can return them to the rectory at any time by placing them in the mail slot of the rectory door, lower right side or you can also place them in the collection basket labeled "REP/Lisa O".

If this is a new registration you will need to provide a birth certificate and a baptismal certificate at time of registration. Please call the rectory for an appointment (312.842.2744) or I will be in the back of the church on September 8th and 9th before and after the masses.

This ten week comprehensive course studies scripture, Church history, and Catholic teachings in a way to help adult Catholics better understand our faith and discern how to live a more intentional, Catholic Christian life. Watch our bulletin and website for more information. There will be a personal invitation at all masses the weekend of Septmer 8<sup>th</sup>-9<sup>th</sup>.

Bishop Barron's new parish study THE SOURCE AND SUMMIT OF OUR FAITH will start in late September. Bishop Barron offers inspiring insights into the mystery of Christ's presence in our lives and the centrality of the Eucharist as an important part of that presence. So many believers do not understand the Eucharist, which Vatican II said is the "source and summit of the Christian life." This fresh look at the Eucharist brings to light its reality as sacred meal, the sacrifice necessary for communion with God, and the Real Presence of Christ. More details later.....

**Renew My Church** Our area grouping ended Phase 2 of RMC in early May and presented our Cardinal and the Renew My Church Committee our recommendations. We will not know the Cardinal's decision until November of this year. I wish that I could tell you more about what our future will look like. The RMC Committee recognizes how awkward the timing of the decision will be for all parishes in Wave I and have made changes to ensure that this will not happen in upcoming Waves. I do not want to speculate on how Cardinal Cupich will decide and I ask all parishioners to continue to pray for him and the committee. We will have a parish Town Hall meeting in October so I can present to you our parish's financial report for fiscal year 2017-18 and I will use that time to share any RMC updates.

The delay in the Cardinal's decision has not been helpful for our parish planning. I have suspended our church renovations until we find out our future configuration. It is not fair for me to ask you for continued financial support of our church renovations without knowing our future. The next phase of our renovation will be more intensive. The flooring support underneath the baptismal font by St. Anthony's statue needs to be rebuilt and the marble tiles in the sanctuary refitted. Let us all pray for the patience we need and for the help and intercession of our patron, St. Anthony. Peace. Fr. Peter

**Renueve Mi Iglesia** Nuestra agrupación de área terminó la Fase 2 de RMC a principios de mayo y presentamos a nuestro Cardenal y al Comité de Renovación de Mi Iglesia nuestras recomendaciones. No sabremos la decisión del cardenal hasta noviembre de este año. Deseo poder contarte más sobre cómo será nuestro futuro. El Comité de RMC reconoce cuán incómodo será el momento de la decisión para todas las parroquias en la Ola I y ha realizado cambios para garantizar que esto no ocurra en las próximas Waves. No quiero especular sobre cómo decidirá el Cardenal Cupich y les pido a todos los feligreses que sigan orando por él y por el comité. Tendremos una reunión del Ayuntamiento de la parroquia en octubre para poder presentarles el informe financiero de nuestra parroquia para el año fiscal 2017-18 y utilizaré ese tiempo para compartir las actualizaciones de RMC. La demora en la decisión del Cardenal no ha sido útil para la planificación de nuestra parroquia. He suspendido las renovaciones de nuestra iglesia hasta que descubramos nuestra configuración futura. No es justo para mí pedirle apoyo financiero continuo para las renovaciones de nuestra iglesia sin conocer nuestro futuro. La próxima fase de nuestra renovación será más intensiva. El soporte del suelo debajo de la fuente bautismal de la estatua de San Antonio necesita ser reconstruido y las baldosas de mármol en el santuario remodelado. Oremos todos por la paciencia que necesitamos y por la ayuda e intercesión de nuestro patrón, San Antonio. Paz. P. Pedro
